

Optometrists and Dispensing Opticians Board (Fees Amendment) Notice 2024

Under sections 130 to 133 of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003, the Optometrists and Dispensing Opticians Board ("Board") gives notice that fees and levy (GST included), set out in the Fees Schedule below, are payable effective from 1 February 2024.

Commencement

This notice comes into effect on 1 February 2024, and sets the updated schedule of fees payable to the Board. Amendments pertains to the APC fees payable for applications relating to the practising year commencing on 1 April 2024, and registration fees. All other fees remain unchanged.

As of 1 February 2023, the following notice is revoked: *Optometrists and Dispensing Opticians (Fees) Notice 2023 (New Zealand Gazette, 23 December 2022, Gazette Number 2023-gs24)*¹.

A. REGISTRATION

Optometrists or Dispensing opticians' graduates registering with the Board for the first time

Applications for the registration in the provisional optometrist scope of practice (For	\$365.00
new graduates from an accredited and recognised New Zealand or Australian	
education and training provider, who applies for registration with the Board, within	
12 months after graduating.)	
Applications for the registration in the provisional optometrist scope of practice.	\$479.00
(For graduates from a New Zealand or Australian training institution, and who will	
register for the first time, more than 12 months after graduating.)	

Australian registered optometrists, applying to register with Board

Application for registration from Australian registered optometrists pursuant to the \$479.00 Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act of 1997 (TTMRA).

C. MAINTAINING REGISTRATION FOR NON-PRACTISING PRACTITIONERS

Application for maintaining registration and receiving communication from the \$100.00 Board.

Application for maintaining registration, receiving communication from the Board, and maintaining recertification requirements (For non-practicing practitioners who wish to continue to meet the Board's recertification requirements. This will include the recording of continuing professional development (CPD) credits, including ethical and cultural CPD points, and may be selected for a random self-audit.)

D. MONITORING REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION OR COMPETENCE RELATED MATTERS

Registration related supervision or mentoring session required by the Board (hourly \$115.00 fee). (A session is usually between 1 to 3 hours long. If a supervision report is required, ad additional hour will be charged.)

Competence or conduct related supervision or mentoring session required by the \$115.00 Board (hourly rate). (A session is usually between 1 to 3 hours long. If a supervision report is required, an additional hour will be charged.)

E. RECERTIFICATION

Assessment of documents / portfolio (The assessment of a portfolio of evidence of a practitioner seeking recognition of prior learning (RPL), or credit accumulation and transfer for formal recognition for any part of the recertification programme with the Board.)
